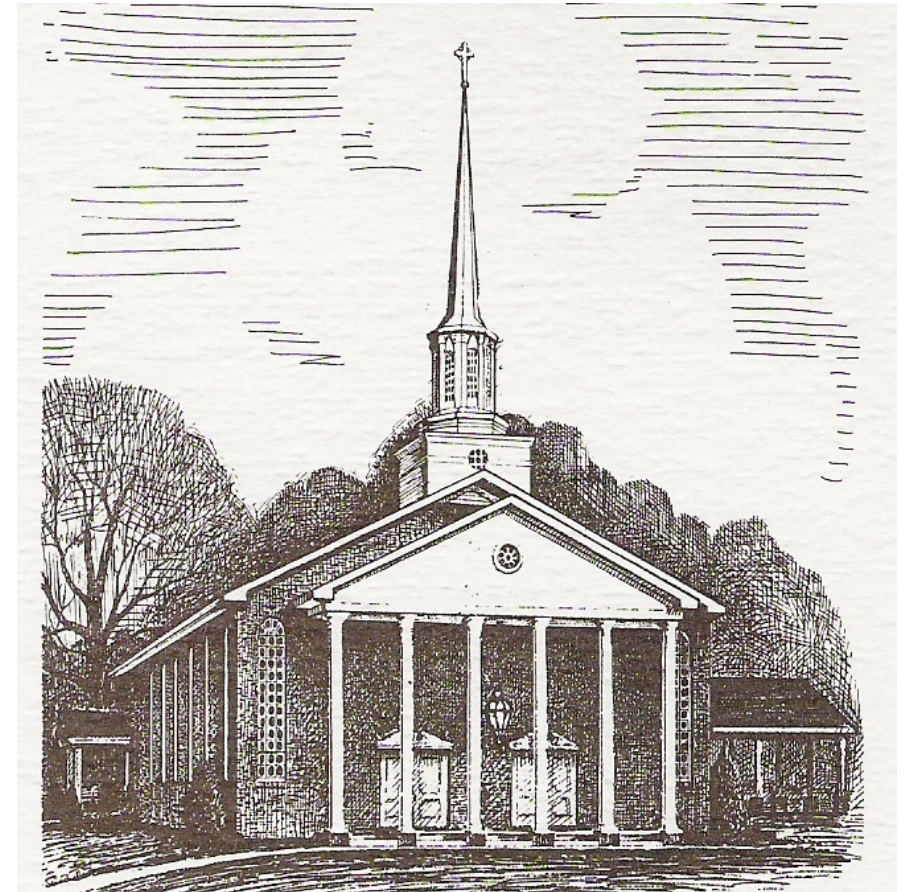

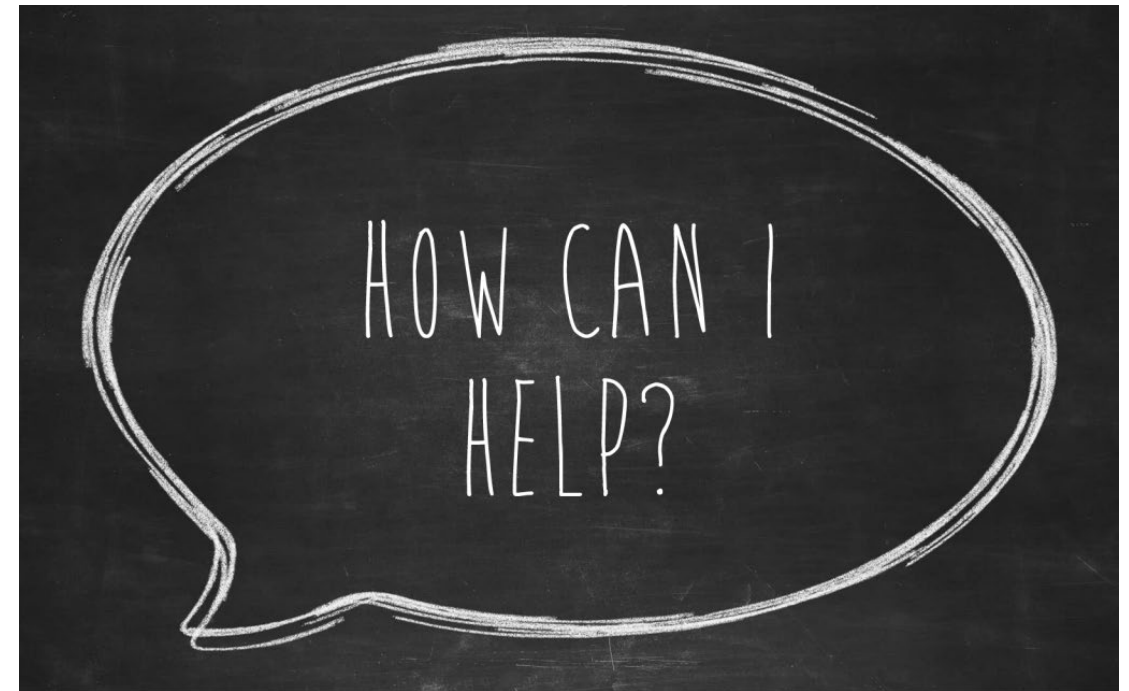
THE CROSS OF CHRIST PROJECT
