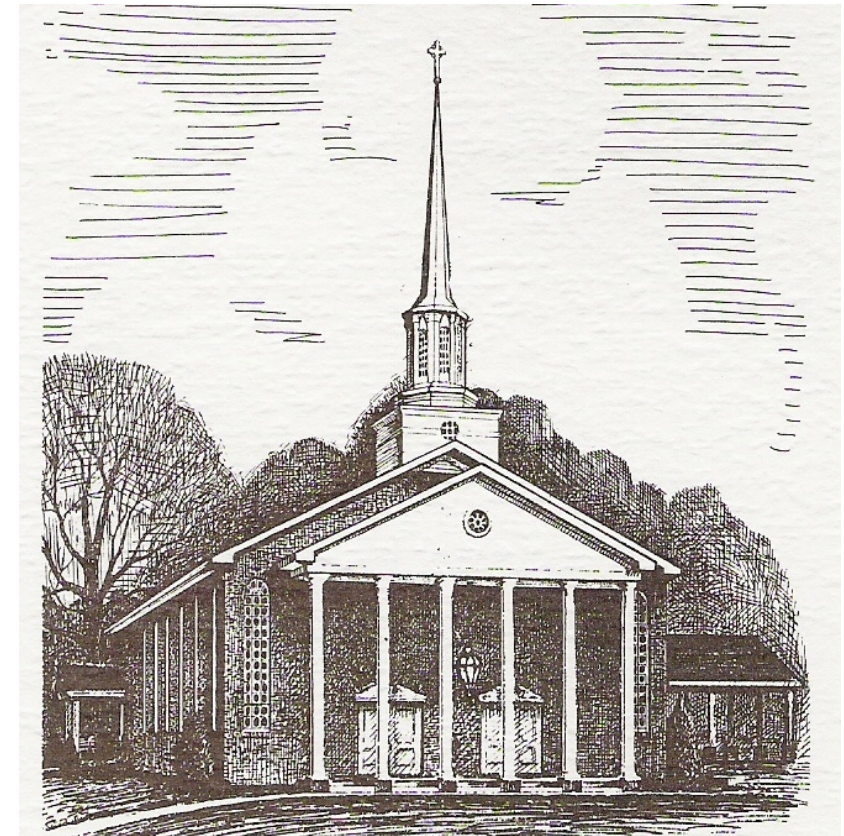

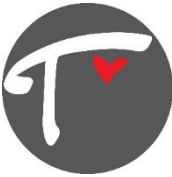


The RPC Office will be closed July 18 – July 28.
